Black Studies World History 3/4

Students will pick a STEM pathway in either School of Biomedical Life Sciences (SOLS), School of Engineering and Design (SOED) or School of Computer Science (SOCS) and take .50 credit elective per semester. Students will remain in the pathway for the next three years, with an optional fourth year.

Check the box for your **Pathway preference** below:

School of Biomedical Life Sciences (SOLS)

This pathway allows students to explore topics in Life Sciences such as Applied Molecular Biology, Physiology, Biomedical Science and UW Biology 100. In 10th grade, you will be in Physiology A/B.

School of Engineering and Design (SOED)

This pathway allows students to explore topics in engineering such as Engineering Design and Development 1 & 2, Intro to Engineering 1 & 2 and Principles of Engineering 1 & 2. In 10th grade, you will take Intro to Engineering 1 & 2.

School of Computer Science (SOCS)

This pathway allows students to explore topics in Computer Science such as Intro to Programming, Immersive Media, AP Computer Science Principles and AP Computer Science, with the option to take Projects in Computer Science in 12th Grade. In 10th grade, you will take AP Computer Science Principles 1/2.
